

1941. Drafted into Manhattan Project, third in command under General Groves and Dr. Oppenheimer. Teaches 200,000 hillbillies in Oak Ridge area to come out of grass huts and read dials for him.
1944. Publishes Henry Miller's *Murder the Murderers* anonymously so won't lose job.
August 7, 1945. Quits Manhattan Project in response to the dropping of the atomic bomb. Starts guilt trip to last rest of life.

THE BOOK OF DO'S

Bern Porter, once a nuclear physicist, is a legendary figure among a group of Fluxus writers, happeners, poets, and mail art aficionados. Now 74, he has worked in underground presses for 40 years, dispensing his own carefully honed visual poems as well as such writers as Henry Miller, when no other American dared tackle him.

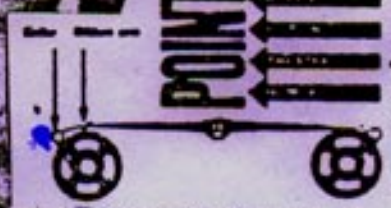

Bern Porter


Bern Porter is a pioneer, 20th century avant-garde artist, who has made major contributions as a visual poet, publisher, physicist, performance artist and essayist.

The undisputed father of "found" art, Porter is a leading poet and performance artist. He has worked in underground presses for 40 years, dispensing his own carefully honed visual poems as well as the works of others. He has published over 58 books of his own work including *The Book of Do's*(1982), *Found Poems*(1972), *The Manhattan Phone Book*(1972), *The Wastemaker, 1926-1981*(1972), *Gee-Whizzels*(1978), *Dieresis*(1969)and *Sweet End*(1988). In addition to his own work, he was the first American to publish Kenneth Patchen, Anais Nin, Kenneth Rexroth, and Henry Miller's antiwar *Murder the Murderers*.

Once a nuclear physicist, Porter helped develop the cathode-ray tube, the picture tube coating that made television possible, and ionospheric broadcasting. He also worked on the Manhattan Project and on the manned space program for NASA. During the 1940's he abandoned his career as a physicist and turned his attention to unifying the arts and sciences in what he calls "Sciart."

"Some of the found poetry of Bern Porter is like this - you can open a book and see things there that look like poems, but they're laundry lists, or they're cut-up bits of ads, or pages of mail-order catalogues. Whatever. But in some way they become poems too, particularly, say, the way a really good found-poet like Bern Porter utilizes them." - Jerome Rothenberg

"When one speaks of Porter, one has to ask which Porter one is speaking of: the atomic physicist, the poet, the surrealist, the first U. S. publisher of Henry Miller and of a number of the best poets of his generation; the sculptor, the early practitioner of 'found poetry,' the graphic illustrator, etc. Most of what is most lively, technically, in the cultural environment today has been touched on by Porter at some time over the past 30 years." - Dick Higgins

Satellite falling

WASHINGTON — The Solar Maximum satellite, repaired in orbit by a space shuttle crew five years ago, will plunge to Earth this weekend, with most of it burning up along the way.

"We expect it to come down on Dec. 2, plus or minus 24 hours," Capt. Thomas Niemann of the U.S. Space Command in Colorado said Monday.

In the satellite's path are much of South America, Africa, India, Australia and the southernmost tip of China. South Florida and the extreme southern part of Texas and Hawaii are the only U.S. areas along the track.

Solar Max cost \$77 million to build and launch in February 1980.
